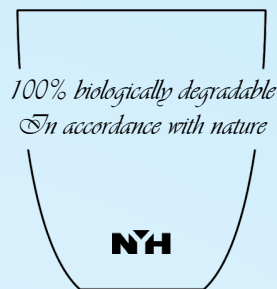


# CERTIFICATE

Urns of natural material – biologically degradable  
from New-York Hamburger AG



The test piece Arboform LV 100 has been analyzed for a period of 120 days according to the mentioned conditions. The following has been ascertained:

After 65 days the test piece has been dissolved by 50%. 120 days are required to dissolve the test piece completely.

According to the conditions of DIN-ISO1 4851/114852 more than 90% of the material Arboform LV 100 has been dissolved and is therefore to be classified as completely bio-degradable.

According to the evaluation of the experimental runs it can be expected that after 3 – 5 years the biological material of the urns has been decomposed in such a way that excavations will not show any recognizable pieces of the material of the urns.

Furthermore we hereby confirm that Arboform LV 100 is not biologically degradable if it is not exposed to microorganisms (water, bacteria, fungus).

The consistency of the material exposed to air (e.g. columbaria, exhibitions) and aqueous environments (rivers, lakes, sea) can be compared to wood.
